

H.J. Dyos and M. Wolff, Eds., The victorian city. Images and realities. Vol. 1: Past and Present/ Numbers of people. London: Routledge and Kegan Paul, 1976 £ 4.95; Vol. 2: Shapes on the ground/ A change of accent. London: Routledge and Kegan Paul 1978, £ 6.95.

Dyos' and Wolff's originally two volume work on the social history of life in the victorian city (published in 1973) is now partially available in paperback. The reader presents fascinating account of everyday life in England of the 19th century. It covers topics like pubs, popular literature, estate development in London and Sheffield, the development of the railway system. The extensive collections of old photographs also to be found in the paperback edition is able to convey additional, more pictorial impressions about aspects of everyday life in Britain at that time.
